NATIONAL CYCLE GLADIATOR


STAY WARMER, BE COOLER BY REG KITTRELLE

No matter how nice they are to have on a trip or a cold morning, windshields can subtract significant style points from your ride. That's the main reason Harley's innovative quickdetach windshields are so popular. Harley, though, doesn't have a lock on innovation as evidenced by the new Gladiator windshield from National Cycle.

Easily mounted on the handlebar clamp using a 1/4-inch Allen wrench and a 7/16-inch wrench (on the pictured Sportster), the Gladiator features a dual-pivot mount that quickly allows you to place it in a more protective upright position, lay it flat for a sleeker look, or adjust it to any position in between. This adjustability also aids in fitting the shield to a wide range of rider sizes. Additionally, the simple mount is mostly hidden, giving the shield a floating look.

Manufactured from a hard-coated polycarbonate material, the 14.5-inchhigh by 12.5-inch-wide shield is available in a dark or light tint. The mounting hardware comes in chrome or black. The Gladiator is available for XL, FX, and FL (Softail) models. We mounted ours on an XL883.

Because of the handlebar clamp-mounted speedometer, the XL883 fitting does not offer as wide a range of adjustment as it does with other Harley models. However, as you can see by the pictures, its adjustability is still quite good. With the Gladiator you can stay warmer, and be cooler.
